Benefit Features	
Providers	Your vision care plan covers the following services if the ophthalmologist, optometrist or optician you choose is a contracting vision care provider with Regence BlueCross BlueShield of Oregon. If you choose a provider who is not a contracting vision care provider you will be reimbursed for 70% of actual or contracted charges, whichever is less.
Examination	Your plan will pay for one examination every 24 months for you and your eligible dependents age 19 and over, and every 12 months for children under 19 years of age up to the contracted amount.
Lenses	Your plan will pay up to the maximum allowance for one pair of standard size and quality white glass or white plastic lenses every 24 months for you and your eligible dependents age 19 and over, and every 12 months for children under 19 years of age.
Frames	Your plan will pay up to the contracted amount for frames for you and your eligible dependents every 24 months when necessary to accommodate newly prescribed lenses.
Contact Lenses	<p>Your plan will pay up to the maximum allowance for one pair of contact lenses every 24 months for you and your eligible dependents age 19 and over, and every 12 months for children under 19 years of age, if they are necessary after cataract surgery or if they are the only means to correct vision to 20/70 or better.</p> <p>If contact lenses are selected as an alternative to lenses and a frame, covered expenses are limited to the amount that would have been paid for regular lenses and a frame. Payment is based on the type of contact lenses purchased (single, bifocal, or trifocal).</p>

Services And Supplies Not Covered

- Treatment of eyes or special procedures such as orthoptics and vision training.
- Charges for fashion eyewear features such as flintglass, blended, coated, tinted (except tints #1 and #2), or oversize lenses.
- Additional charges for partially covered frames.
- Any extra charge for lenses with prisms, prism segs, slab-off, and other special-purpose vision aids.
- Replacement of lenses and frames at a time the covered person is not otherwise eligible for new lenses and frames.
